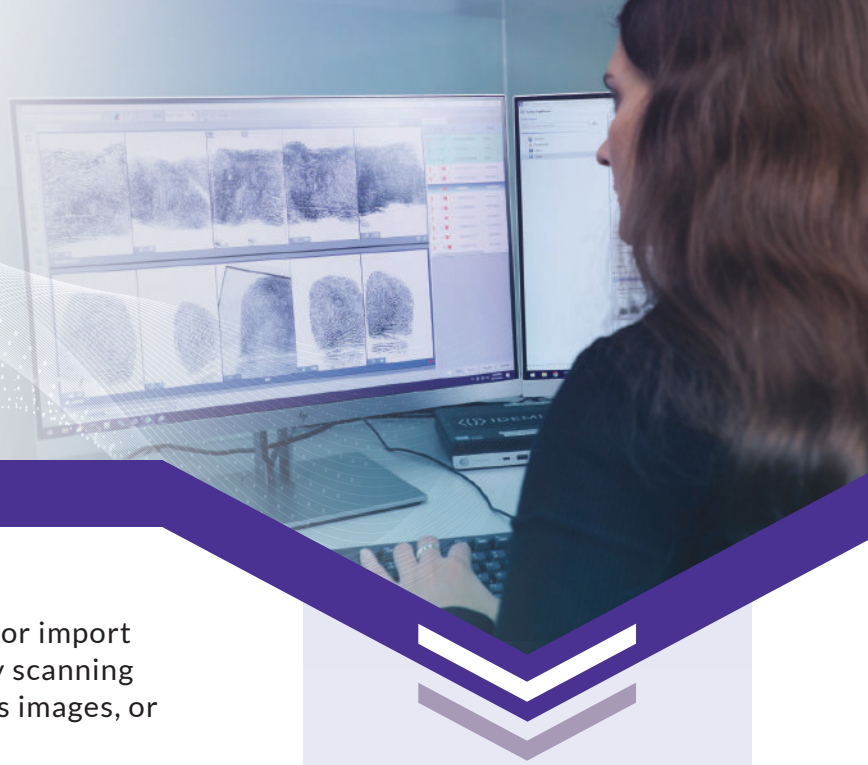


## MBIS Card Capture

Processing of hard copy fingerprint and palm print cards into MBIS



IDEMIA MBIS Card Capture supports scanning or import of hard copy fingerprint and palm print cards by scanning paper cards, importing already scanned cards as images, or importing ANSI/NIST-formatted records

Images from fingerprint cards are captured using an IDEMIA-certified FBI Image Quality Specifics (IQS) Appendix F flat bed scanner. An entire fingerprint/palm print card or supplemental (Major Case Prints) card can be captured at 500 pixels per inch (ppi) or 1,000 ppi in 256 shades of gray.

At the MBIS Card Capture workstation, the operator scans the images on the card into the application, and can enter demographic data associated with the record.

MBIS Card Capture can be configured to support a wide array of fingerprint and palm print card formats, allowing for quick and easy processing of transactions into MBIS. It can also support a free form capability, allowing the operator to process an undefined card format. The operator can adjust the locations of the prints on the card individually, globally (across the whole card), or as a single line of images, allowing for quick adjustments as needed.
